Under general supervision, performs security related activities on BPHC buildings and grounds.
Protects and safeguards BPHC property from fire, theft, vandalism and illegal entry.
Performs duties and responsibilities in accordance with BPHC standards and policies.
Performs other duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

High school diploma or GED required. Proof will be required upon hire.
Successful completion of the Special Police Officers Examination administered by the Boston Police Department.
Must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age.
Valid Class 3 Massachusetts Drivers license. A copy of the RMV driving record will be required.
Must be eligible for appointment as Special Police Officer under the provisions of Chapter 147 of the Massachusetts General Laws.
This position requires direct client/patient contact and as a result of such direct contact, certain immunizations will be recommended and/or required prior to commencement of employment duties.
A Criminal Offenders Records Information request must be completed for this position. However, a record is not an automatic bar to employment but is reviewed in relation to the job applied for.
Boston Residency required, or willingness to relocate.
