




- Data include Boston residents only

  - "Sleeping TB"











#### Incidence of TB: Boston, 2000-2015










### Percent of Reported TB Cases by Age Group: Boston, 2013-2015



### Percent of Reported Tuberculosis Cases by Race/Ethnicity: Boston, 2013-2015










### TB Cases by Birthplace: Boston, 2013-2015



#### Length of US Residence for Foreign Born TB Cases Prior to TB Diagnosis: Boston, 2013-2015



### Primary Site of TB Disease: Boston, 2015





### Completeness of HIV Testing\* of TB Cases: Boston, 2013-2015






# Boston Residents with Latent TB Infection (N=1,080) Evaluated at the BPHC TB Clinic, Incidence by Gender: 2015






# Boston Residents with Latent TB Infection (N=1,080) Evaluated at the BPHC TB Clinic, Incidence by Age Group: 2015






# Percent of Boston Residents with Latent TB Infection (N=1,080) Evaluated at the BPHC TB Clinic by Race/Ethnicity: 2015
