

## **Important Instructions for Ryan White Part A Providers on Completing the "Services" Page of the Ryan White Services Report (RSR) Website**

The "Services" page on both the Grantee Report and Provider Report sections of the RSR website asks for service providers to indicate what services they were funded for and information on those served within those categories.

For more information about the "Service" page on the Grantee Report, refer to pg. 5 of the "RSR Instruction Manual Version 2.1".

Below is a crosswalk of the Boston EMA Service categories and the categories listed in the RSR. Please select the correct category.

Medical Transportation	Medical Transportation services	All transportation programs should report under this category
Mental Health	Mental Health services

Outpatient/ Ambulatory medical care	Outpatient/ Ambulatory medical care	
Psychosocial Support	Psychosocial Support	
Substance Abuse (outpatient)	Substance Abuse Services-outpatient	Only SA programs that provide outpatient services should use this category
Substance Abuse (residential)	Substance Abuse Services-residential	SA programs providing residential bed days should use this category

**IMPORTANT: Agencies should report on those services that they were funded for during the RSR period. If your agency stopped receiving Part A funding as of June 30, 2011, you are STILL REQUIRED to report Part A services provided from Jan – Jun '11.**
