PAGE 4-CORRECTION

On-Going Clients

Quality of Life Outcomes

- **Incorrect:** Clients in the *Southeast* and *Central* regions were more likely than clients in other regions to cope with stress.
- **Correct:** Clients in the *Southeast* region were more likely than clients in other regions to cope with stress.

PAGE 5-CORRECTION

On-Going Clients

Quality of Life Outcomes

- **Incorrect:** Clients in the *Northeast* and *Central* regions were more likely than clients in other regions to have lower depression levels.
- **Correct:** Clients in the *Central* region were more likely than clients in other regions to have lower depression levels.
- **Incorrect:** Clients in *Metro West, Southeast and Central* were more likely than clients in other regions to have lower levels of side effects.
- **Correct:** Clients in the *Southeast* region were more likely than clients in other regions to have lower levels of side effects.

Data Sets

Incorrect:

Using the unique client code identifiers reported on the outcomes measurement instrument; Cohort demographics were matched and exported from the BPHC Database, and merged into the Outcomes Database (n=2,925).

Figures 2A-2C show FY03 demographic data provided by the Boston Public Health Commission for the Title I EMA Epidemiological Profile (n=15,828) and the Boston Title I EMA Service Profile (n=7,672).

Correct:

Regional analysis was performed on data collected in FY03. The data set was constructed by combining outcomes measurement reports from the March 2003-Aug 2003 and the Sept 2003-Feb 2004 reporting periods representing 1,903 new clients and 4,655 on-going clients (Figures 2A and 2B).

Using unique client code identifiers reported on the outcomes measurement instrument, zip codes were exported from the BPHC Database and merged into the Outcomes Database.

On-Going Clients

Quality of Life Outcomes

- **Incorrect:** Ability to advocate outcomes scores are significantly higher for clients in the *New Hampshire* region.
- **Correct:** Ability to advocate outcomes scores are significantly higher for clients in the *Southeast* and *New Hampshire* regions.
