

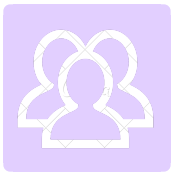


# COMMUNITY ACTION NETWORK (CAN)

Our Mission is to eliminate racial inequities in infant mortality and poor birth outcomes by mobilizing the community to do outreach, education, and policy change.

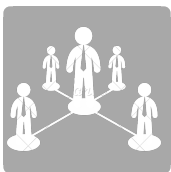
## What is the CAN?
