CHEC TRAINING PROGRAMS

CHEC offers a range of courses that expand CHWs' knowledge of public health concepts and practices and help them build skills in: Leadership Development • Community Organizing • Advocacy • Community Health Education • Community Engagement

Comprehensive Outreach Education Certificate Program (COEC)

COEC is an 80-hour training program that focuses on core CHW competencies, skills and strategies for community outreach and health education practice.

Fee: \$650 includes all health modules

Health Modules Sessions

Three-to-five hour sessions focusing on health facts and local referral resources so that CHWs can provide health information and referrals on a broad range of health topics to their communities.

Fee: \$25/half day and \$50/full day

Health Education Skill Building Workshops

Build CHW skills to help individual clients make changes to improve their health.

- Health Education Models for Behavior Change
- Motivational Interviewing Techniques
- Harm Reduction

Fee: \$25/half day and \$50/full day

Training/Facilitation Method Workshops

Improve training and facilitation skills for working with groups. The workshops are rooted in adult learning principles that emphasize interactive learning techniques.

- Train-the-Trainer (Fee: \$150 for 3 day workshop)
- Curriculum Design (Fee: \$50 for 1 day workshop)
- Presentation Tips & Techniques (Fee: \$150 for 3 day workshop)

Career Advancement Workshops

Support CHWs in their professional development by enhancing their skill level and capacity.

- CHW Supervisory Skills (Fee: \$75 for 2 day workshop)
- Stress Management (Fee: \$50 for 1 day workshop)
- Professional Writing Skills (Fee: \$150 for 6 session workshop)

In-depth Health Seminars

Provide more in-depth information and cultural appropriate prevention strategies on selected health topics. The seminars also provide community resources and referrals to better help clients in dealing with these issues.

- Violence Prevention Seminar
- Addiction Seminar

Fee: \$25 for each half day session
