How can I talk to my healthcare provider about cancer screenings?



Call your provider and schedule an appointment.



Be prepared to ask your provider questions such as:

- Which cancers should I be screened for?
- How often should I get these screenings?
- Will my screenings be covered by my health insurance? If not, how much will they cost?

How will my provider decide which cancer screenings I should get?

Age



Racial/ethnic background



Family history of cancer



Personal health history
