Request for Proposal: Safe and Successful Youth Initiative- Education and Occupational Training and Employment Services

Proposal Due Date: Tuesday, May 31, 2022 5:00 PM EST

All Prospective Proposers: In reference to the proposal solicitation, the following questions and inquiries were submitted, and received a response from Boston Public Health Commission below.

1. Whether companies from Outside USA can apply for this (examples: from India or Canada)?
Answer: No, we will not be accepting proposals from organizations outside of the United States.
2. Whether we need to come over there for meetings?
Answer: Partners agree to participate in quarterly review meetings. In addition to quarterly review meetings, contracted providers, who have clients enrolled in SSYI programming, are required to attend statewide trainings held by EHOSS. Due to the pandemic, quarterly review meetings and trainings are currently held virtually. SSYI will resume in person meetings in compliance with local, state, and federal guidelines.
3. Can we perform the tasks (related to RFP) outside USA (from India or Canada)?
Answer: The Boston Public Health Commission will not be accepting proposals from organizations outside of the United States.
4. Can we submit proposals via email?
Answer: Proposals must be submitted via email to Rmartin@bphc.org and Aboehler@bphc.org. The subject line for proposal submissions must include [Vendor Name] Safe and Successful Youth Initiative Proposal.
5. In review is there a deadline before submission of May 2022? Is there an earlier submission deadline?
Answer: There is no earlier submission deadline. Proposals will be accepted through May 31, 2022. Submissions after May 31, 2021 will be reviewed for contracting in Fiscal Year 2022 (July 1, 2021- June 30, 2022).
