- Anjali Nath, Director of Asthma Prevention & Control, represented BPHC at the State House this month.
 - Testified @ the Joint Committee on Public Health in support of the Prevention and Wellness Trust Fund (PWTF).
 - Highlighted our leadership in the Boston Partnership with our partners in the areas of hypertension, asthma and elder falls.
- Monitoring state budget process & partnering with City Hall and coalitions to advocate for funding
- Senate proposal for state budget includes:
 - 3.1% increase in spending over last year, buoyed by new taxes on opioid manufacturers and vaping products
 - A new \$10 million mental health trust fund, which would launch a public awareness campaign aimed at reducing stigma and create a program to forgive student-loan debt for behavioral health care workers
